Energy poverty phase: Diagnosis



Topics: Information and awareness

The **City of Zamość**, in collaboration with the **Polish Network Energie-Cités (PNEC)**, developed a technical assistance to assess and analyse energy poverty in the region and develop a local strategy to mitigate its effects.

Objectives

The technical assistance aimed to help the city assess current conditions, identify data gaps, and develop a methodological approach for collecting this missing data. Moreover, the project focused on analysing data, suggesting local solutions based on successful practices, and integrating the issue of energy poverty into local strategic planning.

Activities & Outcomes

baseline The conducted team covering population assessment characteristics, energy sources, and the profile of those at risk of energy poverty. Workshops led to a methodology for diagnosing energy poverty and a detailed campaign plan. A leaflet for distribution in the city was prepared, along with a mobile app section on energy-saving tips. A threephase **roadmap** that guides actions against energy poverty was finalised. Additionally, 2 workshops were developed to bring awareness on the topics of diagnosis and funding opportunities.

involvement was only partial, the awareness campaign was effectively executed. It's positive to note that municipal engagement has improved over time.
