

Integral municipal service of attention and guidance in terms of supplies and rehabilitation.



Generate participative strategies with people identifying problems and finding solutions together, guided by experts



- Structural Obstacles: How to Address Energy Communities from Local Administration
- **1. Engagement of Municipal Departments:** We made a concerted effort to involve various departments within the city council right from the start. The most crucial areas that participated included urban planning, social services, sustainability, housing, and maintenance.
- **2.** Developing an Agenda Grounded in Real Opportunities, Not Just Abstract Possibilities: Initially, we focused on tangible opportunities rather than abstract possibilities, as evidenced by our work with the PIREP program at the outset.
- **3.** Generating Synergies with Other Ongoing Projects and Initiatives: We actively sought to create synergies with other projects and ongoing efforts in progress.







1. Engagement of Municipal Departments:

Integrating different departments and areas is not optional:

from housing to...social services informatics, data protection, legal services, health area, consumer information office, neighbor attention services, woman area, senior area, youth area, civic centers... (+20 services)







2. Develop an Agenda Grounded in Real Opportunities

At the end, we focused on tangible opportunities rather than abstract possibilities, as evidenced by our work with the PIREP program from the outset.





Have a clear plan to follow, including Plan A, Plan B, and so on.

Strive to develop it with the support of various departments and areas.











3. Generating Synergies with Other Ongoing Projects and Initiatives:

We actively sought to create synergies with other projects and ongoing initiatives.







Working on different lines and projects in parallel, with the goal of fostering interaction and strengthening their collective impact, rather than operating in isolation among projects.
